Flock 1e, Flock 2, Flock 2b and Flock 2c Private Remote Sensing License: Public Summary

On 17 February 2015, the Commercial Remote Sensing Regulatory Affairs Office of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, an agency of the Department of Commerce, granted a license to Planet Labs Inc. to operate a private, commercial, space-based, remote sensing system consisting of the launch of up to 150 “Dove” satellites. Each launch of a constellation of “Dove” satellites is designated as a “Flock”, more info shown below. The “Dove” satellites are licensed to collect images of the Earth and will operate in Low Earth Orbit.

1. Flock 1e – up to 26 satellites, nominal orbit 400 km x 400 km, 51.6 deg inclination
2. Flock 2 – up to 42 satellites, nominal orbit 470 km x 470 km, 97.3 deg inclination
3. Flock 2b – up to 26 satellites, nominal orbit 400 km x 400 km, 51.6 deg inclination
4. Flock 2c – up to 56 satellites, nominal orbit 450 km x 720 km, 98.0 deg inclination
