**Private Remote Sensing System License Summary of  
GeoEye-2 & 3**

On January 10, 2006 the National Environmental Satellite, Data and Information Service of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (“NOAA”), and agency of the Department of Commerce, granted a license to ORBIMAGE SI Opco Inc. d/b/a/ GeoEye to operate a private, commercial, space-based, remote sensing system named IKONOS Block II. On May 14, 2010 the IKONOS Block II license was updated in connection with the corporate name change of ORBIMAGE SI Opco Inc. to GeoEye Solutions Inc. The name of the licensed satellite system was later changed to GeoEye-2 & 3. On January 31, 2013 DigitalGlobe, Inc. completed its acquisition GeoEye, Inc. and its subsidiaries.

The license granted by NOAA permits DigitalGlobe to operate a low earth orbit, electro-optical imaging system which is capable of collecting, for commercial distribution, panchromatic data at a spatial resolution no better than 0.5 meters and multispectral data at a spatial resolution no better than 2.0 meters.

The GeoEye-2 & 3 License permits the satellites to orbit Earth at 500 km to 770 km altitudes between 97.4 degrees at 500 km and 98.4 degrees at 770 km sun synchronous inclination.
