2. The satellite is called ORS Squared. It is a 6U CubeSat that weighs approximately 5kg. The satellite has two cell phone style cameras on board that will be used to take pictures of the dispenser as it is deployed. This is a new type of dispenser so being able to record images of it will help to provide the developers with feedback on its performance. The satellite has no ability to be aimed or pointed. The remainder of the satellite is a series of flight experiments such as a deployable boom and deployable solar array. All data downloaded will be processed through the Operationally Responsive Space office for release. The anticipated launch date is 23 January, 2015. The anticipated orbit is 525km by 450km with a 93 degree inclination.
